

2007 USATF SOUTHWESTERN ASSOCIATION JUNIOR OLYMPIC TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Rules

The Association Meet will be governed by all current USATF competition rules.

Proof of Age

Proof of age must be submitted along with each entry. Proof of age shall be a copy of the athlete's birth certificate, school record, baptismal record, driver's license or US Government identification.

Divisions

The meet is divided into six (6) divisions for male and female. The athlete's year of birth shall determine the division in which the athlete shall compete.

***Athletes who are still 18 through the final day of Junior Olympics (August 1) are eligible to compete in the Young Division.**

Eligibility

Competition is open to all athletes in good standing with the Association and USA Track & Field. A current USATF membership card is required for each athlete. To represent a club, the club must be a member of the Association and the USATF and be in good standing. You must be a club to compete in relays.

Entry Forms

Entry forms and computer entries are due by June 9, ²⁰⁰⁷. Please use a separate entry form for each division and gender. Duplicate all as necessary. Late entries will not be accepted. Changes can be made until June 15, 2007. **No athletes can be added or subtracted, no changes to events after June 15, 2007.**

Protests

Protests related to matters which develop during the conduct of the competition, must be made in writing to the meet referee at once and no later than 30 minutes after the results have been announced. The proper rule or reference must be cited. A fee of \$75.00 cash deposit must accompany all protests. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld or forfeited if the protest is denied.

Scratches

No scratches are allowed

Association Entry Fee – Athletes

There will be a fee of \$6.00 per event (\$24.00 per relay). Fees must accompany the entry form(s) and is nonrefundable. Cash, check or money order will be accepted. Personal checks will be allowed unless you have had a discrepancy in the past.

Association Entry Fee – Coaches

Each coach must have a current coach (CH, C1, C2, etc.) USATF Membership Card and must be on the coaches list provided by the head coach to receive an admission pass.

Association Entry Fee – Spectators

\$6.00 per day or \$15.00 for a three (3) day passes.

Regional Entry Fee – Athletes

There will be a fee of \$7.00 per event. (\$28.00 per relay). Fees must accompany the forms due immediately after the Association Championship and before exiting the stadium. Regional entry fees are nonrefundable. Cash, check or money orders will be accepted. Personal checks will be allowed unless you have had a discrepancy in the past.

Regional Entry Fee – Coaches

Each coach must have a current coach (CH, C1, C2, etc.) USATF Membership Card and must be on the coaches list provided by the head coach to receive an admission pass.

Regional Entry Fee – Spectators

\$7.00 per day or purchase a multi day pass at the discretion of the host association.
