## LDR Grand Prix Series

### USATF SW Association Grand Prix Series

The Grand Prix consists of nine road race events. The distances are 5km, 10km, half-marathon, and one additional "wild card" full marathon at double points.

The total prize purse for 2008 will be \$2,150\*\* to be distributed as described below.

### Individual Competition

A. USATF Southwestern Grand Prix scoring is done separately and equally for men and women and all declared runners will be listed in the overall scoring. Age Divisions are from 14 to 39 for females and 16 to 39 for males in accordance with national rules regarding the conduct of LDR events for Open. The age divisions continue with 40 to 49 (Master), 50 to 59 (Senior), 60-70(Super Senior) and 70-and over (Veteran).

The top Overall scorer (male and female) will be recognized for being the winner of the grand prix regardless of his and her age division.

Points are awarded to the top ten USATF-Southwestern Association finishers in each division. The winner will receive one hundred points, and the next finishers are awarded ninety, eighty, seventy, sixty, etc., points respectively. If less than ten athletes participate in a particular division, the winner receives points equal to the number of finishers in that division times ten.

B. Only current USATF members residing in the Southwestern Association are eligible for Grand Prix individual scoring.

*First Place overall male and female will win \$300*

*Second Place overall male and female will win \$150*

*Third Place overall male and female will win \$75*

*Age Division First Place male and female is \$50*

*Age Division Second Place male and female is \$40.*

*Age Division Third Place male and female is \$20.*

C. Each participant must declare for the series prior to any participating event. There will be a sign up at registration or email to declaration form to LDR@SWUSATF.org

To be eligible for prize money an athlete must have completed at least five grand prix races. If an athlete fails to complete the prize money requirements, his place remains the same and no athlete moves up.

\*No duplication of awards. Athletes with High school or collegiate eligibility are not eligible for monetary awards.
